Did you know?

The United States will be consecrated to the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus this coming June 12th, the Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart, to celebrate America's semiquincentennial, that is, the two hundred and fiftieth anniversary of the signing of the Declaration of Independence. What does this mean?

The Devotion to the Sacred Heart is "a worship of and a response to the Person of Christ as viewed from the perspective of His divine and human love which is manifested through His Sacred Humanity and is symbolized by His wounded physical Heart.

The veneration of our Lord's Heart, insofar as it honors Christ as the source and substance of our redemption, is no ordinary devotion. It is truly *latreutical* - a devotion which is rendered to God alone." -Dr. Timothy O'Donnell, *Heart of the Redeemer*

Popes have lauded the practice of consecration of the self, home, and even whole nations to the Sacred Heart. Pope Pius XI, drawing on the teaching of Pope Leo XIII, commended the "pious custom" of consecrating the nation to the Sacred Heart of Jesus as a way to recognize the kingship of Christ. "This anniversary and consecration will be a great opportunity to promote the beautiful devotion to the Sacred Heart." -Archbishop

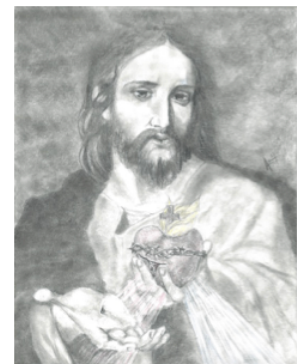
